Stride Center

What is Stride Center?

The Stride Center is a community of caring professionals and assisting partners who provide crisis services for those in need. The Stride Center is an excellent choice when you or a loved one experiences a mental health or substance use crisis. Stride offers same-day help and referral options. Stride Center is an alternative to the hospital emergency department or jail, connecting people to care and recovery resources. Stride can be accessed by individuals in need, first responders, social workers, or concerned community members.

No referrals are needed to be a guest at Stride. Individuals who are experiencing a mental health or substance use crisis are welcome to visit Stride.

A community resource

Police, medics, first responders and community partners such as shelters, pantries and other service providers, can contact Stride to access resources for individuals suffering from mental health or substance use issues.

Our care approach

Our staff is professionally trained in harm reduction, trauma-informed care and crisis intervention. The program is available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week and offers a safe, welcoming environment. Guests will be allowed to stay at the center for up to 23 hours per visit and can make repeat visits.

Who can we help?

We serve:

- Individuals 18 and over suffering from acute mental health and/or substance use issues who are in good behavioral control
- Individuals with suicidal thoughts

We cannot serve:

- Individuals who present an imminent risk of harm or violence to themselves or others

We are a calm place for individuals in crisis

We offer a calm place for individuals to de-escalate their situations, along with one-on-one consultation with professional staff. We provide diversion for individuals in crisis, giving them access to:

- Trained mental health professionals
- Triage and crisis intervention
- Peer support and recovery coaching
- Naloxone (NARCAN) training
- Connection to shelters, food, clothing and other resources

Rapid Response Treatment Team

The Rapid Response Treatment Team emphasizes a "no-wrong-door" approach to care. The team accepts phone, email and in-person referrals. The Rapid Response Team provides:

- Crisis event management
- Crisis care follow-up within 12-24 hours after referral
- Gap care and additional treatment interventions following the crisis until the client is stabilized for appropriate referral(s)
- Interventions including EBTs that are specific to crises such as severe thoughts of suicide and domestic violence

Mobile Crisis Response Team

Our Mobile Crisis Response Team brings mental health resources to you! The team is available 24/7 to assist with problem solving, de-escalation, triage, and connecting to treatment and/or other resources.

The team consists of mental health professionals including Crisis Certified Support Professionals, Crisis Care Specialists, and licensed mental health therapists, that provide mental health crisis care to children, families and adults.

The team assists individuals when they are experiencing a mental health crisis and can't travel to a safe location to access care. We attempt to arrive within 60 minutes depending on capacity and location, and may require up to 90 minutes to reach remote areas.
